



NAMIBIA (from Cape Town)

10 to 21 May 2021



Join us on this magnificent 12-day tour through mystical Namibia, the country of a thousand faces

DAY 1:

Our comfortable bus, adapted for Namibian conditions, departs from **N1 City** in **Cape Town** and follows a pick-up route via **Malmesbury**, **Piketberg**, **Clanwilliam** and **Van Rhynsdorp** for a first night stop-over at **Springbok**.

DAY 2:

We depart from **Springbok** to enter Namibia at the **Vioolsdrif/Noordoewer** border post. With the border formalities done and dusted we travel to the hot springs of **Ai-Ais** where we will spend the night. Enough time is available to explore the area and to have a relaxing afternoon and a well-deserved rest. Swimming is also possible in either the warm open-air or in-door swimming pools.

DAY 3:

After a hearty breakfast we depart for a visit to the impressive **Fish River Canyon**. Then it is off to the quaint **Canyon Roadhouse** for some refreshments before we travel to **Keetmanshoop** via the **Naute Dam**. This will be our home for tonight. During the afternoon we visit two of the many wonders of this interesting country – the inexplicable **Giant's Playground** and the odd **Quiver Tree Forrest**, situated close to **Keetmanshoop**.

DAY 4:

We depart after breakfast and travel to the lonesome town of **Aus**, where an early lunch can be enjoyed. We then proceed through the oldest dessert in the world – the **Namib Desert** with its **feral horses**. Following a visit to the lonely **Dias Cross** at **Angra Pequena**, we arrive at our luxury accommodation, the **Nest Hotel** in typical German town **Luderitz**.

DAY 5:

A delicious breakfast is followed by a guided tour of the nostalgic diamond mining ghost town - **Kolmanskop** before we depart in an easterly direction to reach the **Maltahöhe Hotel**, in the rural town **Maltahöhe**.

DAY 6:

After breakfast we follow the beautiful route through the **Zarispas** to **Sesriem** and the dunes of **Sossusvlei** – the highest dunes in the world. Our bus will take us into the vlei, but the last 5 Km can only be done by 4 X 4 vehicles. This **optional 4X4** drive is made available by **Namibian Wild Life Resorts (NWR)** at approximately **R 200/person**. During the afternoon, we depart for our next overnight stop at the lonely town **Solitaire**.



DAY 7:

We leave **Solitaire** behind and travel in a northerly direction. The route is breath-taking and travels through two beautiful canyons - the **Gaub** and **Kuiseb**. At around lunch time, we arrive in **Swakopmund**. During the afternoon we will explore the very interesting desert with its **Welwitchias** and **Moon Landscape** and then head for **Walvis Bay**, where one of the comfortable hotels will be our home for the next two nights.

DAY 8:

This morning, after breakfast, an exciting boat trip with lots of **sea life** interaction and **scrumptious snacks** (including oysters) is in the offering. This is an **optional** excursion at a cost of approximately **R600.00**. Those who prefer not to join the boat trip can have a relaxing morning at the Hotel. During the afternoon, our fitness will be tested at the infamous **DUNE 7** and tonight we will enjoy a delicious dinner at a **genuine German Restaurant** in **Swakopmund**.

DAY 9:

We leave **Walvis Bay** after breakfast and travel via **Usakos**, **Karibib**, **Omaruru**, and **Otjiwarongo** to enter the **Etosha National Park** at the **von Lindequist Gate**. For the following 2 blissful nights our accommodation will be in the park and we can spend lots of interesting time at the **illuminated Water Holes** in the different camps.

DAY 10:

A lovely day of relaxation and game watching while we find our way to one of the other camps in the park.

DAY 11

We leave after breakfast and travel via **Outjo**, and **Otjiwarongo** to **Okahandja**, the biltong capital of Namibia. Then we depart to the real Capital of Namibia - **Windhoek**. After a short city tour and some shopping, we depart to our overnight accommodation. During the afternoon everybody is free to make use of a **FREE** shuttle service from the hotel to the business centre of **Windhoek**.

DAY 12:

Way to soon, the time has come to leave this wonderful country. After breakfast we depart to the **Hosea Kutako International Airport**, where we will board our flight back to **Cape Town International**. All that remains to be said is:
