



NAMIBIA (from Gauteng)

Tour 3: 14 to 25 June 2021



Join us on this magnificent 12-day tour through mystical Namibia, the country with a thousand faces

DAY 1:

Filled with excitement we check in at **O R Tambo International Airport** for our flight to **Hosea Kutako Airport** near **Windhoek** in **Namibia**. With the border formalities done and dusted we board our comfortable bus, adapted for Namibian conditions, and depart for **Windhoek**. After a short city tour, we depart to our overnight accommodation. During the afternoon everybody is free to make use of the **FREE** shuttle services from the hotel to the business centre of **Windhoek**.



DAY 2:

After breakfast, we depart from Windhoek to travel northward via **Okahandja** (the biltong capital of Namibia), **Otjiwarongo** and **Outjo** to enter **Etosha** at the **Anderson Gate**. For the next 2 nights, we are accommodated in **Okaukuejo** camp and can spend hours at the **illuminated waterhole** in the camp.



DAY 3:

A relaxing day of game watching while we explore the park and its wildlife during game drives in the morning and again in the late afternoon.



DAY 4:

After breakfast we leave the **Etosha National Park** at the **Anderson Gate** and travel via **Outjo**, **Omaruru** and **Usakos** to **Swakopmund**. During the afternoon we explore the very interesting desert with its **Welwitchias** and **Moon Landscape** and then proceed to **Walvis Bay** – our home for the next 2 nights.



DAY 5:

This morning after breakfast an exciting **optional boat cruise** with lots of **sea life** interaction and **scrumptious snacks** is on the menu at a cost of approximately **R600.00 per person**. Those who prefer not to join the boat trip can have a morning at leisure at the Hotel. During the afternoon, our fitness will be tested at the infamous **DUNE 7** and tonight we will enjoy a delicious dinner at a **genuine German Restaurant** in **Swakopmund**.



DAY 6:

We depart after breakfast and follow the route through the desert with two beautiful canyons – that of the **Kuiseb River** and the **Gaub River**. At **Solitaire** we take a breather and then proceed to the world's highest dunes at **Sossusvlei** and the **Sesriem canyon**. At **Sossusvlei**, the last 5 Km is only accessible by **4 X 4 vehicles**. This can optionally be done at a cost of approximately **R 200 per person**. We then proceed to our over-night accommodation at **Hammerstein**.



DAY 7:

We depart from Hammerstein and travel up the beautiful **Zaris Pass** in the **Zaris Mountains**, to reach the fascinating **Duwisib Castle**. From here we proceed to **Helmeringhausen**, home to the best **apple pie** in Namibia (according to the owner of the hotel), where we will catch our breath. Time will also be available for lunch. Then we proceed southward to reach the lonesome town of **Aus** during the late afternoon and our over-night stop for today.



DAY 8:

We depart from **Aus** and travel through the oldest desert in the world – the **Namib Desert**, with its **feral horses**. During the morning, we arrive at **Kolmanskop** for a **guided tour** through this historic ghost town. This is followed by a visit to the lonesome **Diaz cross** at **Angra Pequena** (Little Bay) near **Luderitz**. We head back to the typical German town of **Luderitz** and book into our luxury hotel. The afternoon is at leisure for everyone to explore the beautiful town



DAY 9:

After a delicious breakfast, we depart and travel via **Aus** to **Keetmanshoop**, where we will be accommodated tonight. During the afternoon we visit a further two wonders of this interesting country – the inexplicable **Giant's Playground** and the odd **Quiver Tree Forrest**, situated close to **Keetmanshoop**.



DAY 10:

We depart from **Keetmanshoop** on a route via the **Naute Dam**. At the quaint **Canyon Road House** we pause for a while and then proceed to the breath-taking **Fish River Canyon**. From here our route takes us to the **hot springs** at **Ai-Ais**, where we will enjoy a relaxing time. Enough time will be available to explore the environment and for a nice swim in the warm outdoor or indoor pools.



DAY 11:

This morning we depart from **Ai-Ais** and travel via Grunau and Karasburg to leave **Namibia** at the **Ariamsvlei/Nakop** border post. Having completed the border formalities, we head for **Upington** for our last evening together.



DAY 12:

To soon the time has come to say goodbye. After breakfast we depart for **Pretoria**. The route takes us via Kuruman, Vryburg, Wolmaransstad, Klerksdorp, Potchefstroom and Roodepoort. A wonderful tour comes to an end and all that needs to be said is:

"AUF WIEDERSEHEN"
